



Akevot Institute for Israeli-Palestinian Conflict Research is a centre for documentation, research and promotion of human rights within the context of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. The Research Centre is based in Tel Aviv, Israel and is monitoring mechanism, practices and policies that violate human rights in the context of the conflict and address incidents whose narratives and collective memories have played a role in its perpetuation. Furthermore Akevot is a Human Rights Archive that identifies and digitizes governmental and other documentation held in public and private archives aiming to expand public access to conflict-related documentation in public and private archives and promote the right to the truth and the right to know as individual and collective rights. The Institute seeks to use information and documentation as tools to advocate human rights and a just and sustainable solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and encourages public discussion on the history of the conflicts as well as its impact on current and future events.
