



Hafıza Kaydı (Collective Chronicles) is a civil initiative, an “open platform,” dedicated to deconstructing and reconstructing stories for collective memory through a blend of traditional content and new media. It aims to raise awareness, strengthening the flow of information and enlarge the collective consciousness. It is an effort of creating a collectively produced content and entwists it with an artistic, fictional or documentary communication tool. Hafıza Kaydı was born in the park forums, which began in the fall of 2013, after Gezi Movement. The Gezi Movement gave many people the chance to re-enter the streets and express their demands. The Memory Record was born with this collective energy of establishing dreams and turning the plans in to reality. It began its publication life on January 4, 2015, asking the following question: "Are you in denial, denial, with the burdens of conscience that weaken the possibility of social peace?"
