



**SOS Disparus** receives in its offices in Algeria the victims' families, registers their testimonies about the disappeared, the circumstances of the disappearance etc and writes the complaints it then gives to the authorities. The association has registered about 5000 cases of enforced disappearances in Algeria in the 1990's. SOS Disparus then passes the cases to CFDA who sends them to the United Nations Working Group on Enforced or Involuntary Disappearances or to the United Nations Human Rights Committee. These actions led to the condemnation of Algeria before the Human Rights Committee. SOS Disparus organizes the logistics of events planned by CFDA which takes place in Algeria. It also raises awareness among Algerian associations about the crime of enforced disappearance.
